

Hello Ladies,

We are reaching out to you today to let you know that Valley of the Sun Artists, a non-profit Tole and Decorative Painting Club is seeking teacher submissions for the calendar 2026 year.

We meet on the second Thursday of each month with the exception of July, August and December (there is no painting in these months).

We paint Arizona Time, 9:30 a.m.—12:30 in person and via Zoom.

Zoom has opened up a wonderful opportunity for teachers near and far to be able to share their talents with all new and seasonal painters. Our classes average between 12-20 participants in person and via Zoom. E-packets are acceptable as well as hard copy instructions. Students supply their own surfaces, as we encourage them to use their own stash or purchase directly from the supplier for specific items if required.

Projects that are NOT your design need to have written approval from the original designer before submitting to teach.

We have attached the submission form and we do hope you will consider submitting to teach and share your talents with our club.

VSA Club pays our teachers \$125 for a 3-4 hour class.
